Job Goal: To develop in each pupil an interest in and the ability to express himself creatively in visual terms utilizing skills and techniques of artistic expression

 appropriate to the pupil's interests and abilities; to develop aesthetic understandings and appreciation; to discover and develop talents of pupils

 in the field of art.

Performance Responsibilities:

- 1.) The teacher teaches knowledge and skill in art including crafts, drawing, painting, lettering, design, commercial art, art history, and/or three dimensional art to K-8 pupils utilizing the course of study adopted by the Board of Education and other appropriate learning activities.
- 2.) The teacher instructs pupils in citizenship and basic subject matter specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures of the school district.
- 3.) The teacher provides instruction by which pupils develop aesthetic concepts and appreciation and the ability to make qualitative judgments about art.
- 4.) The teacher instructs pupils in the proper care and use of tools and equipment.
- 5.) The teacher organizes storage area and controls use of materials, equipment, and tools to prevent loss or abuse and to minimize time required for distribution and collection.
- 6.) The teacher is to demonstrate appropriate preparation for classroom instruction.
- 7.) The teacher is implement a variety of effective teaching techniques.
- 8.) The teacher is to provide opportunities for individual student differences.
- 9.) The teacher is to implement instructional objectives effectively.
- 10.) The teacher is to demonstrate knowledge of the subject matter.
- 11.) The teacher is to use a variety of teaching materials.
- 12.) The teacher is to use instructional time effectively.
- 13.) The teacher is to motivate the students in the art classroom.
- 14.) The teacher is to demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively with students.
- 15.) The teacher is to provide students with specific evaluative feedback.
- 16.) The teacher is to demonstrate positive interpersonal relationship with students.

- 17.) The teacher is to demonstrate a positive interpersonal relationship with the parents and patrons of the community.
- 18.) The teacher is to participate in professional growth activities.
- 19.) Beginning in the 1998-99 school year the teacher is to possess the ability to use his/her assigned computer and the following software programs:
 - a.) District selected gradebook
 - b.) District selected e-mail
 - c.) District selected word processing
 - d.) District selected operating system
 - e.) District selected on-line reference
- 20.) The teacher is to follow the policies and procedures of the district as set forth in the staff handbook and board policies of the district.
- 21.) The teacher is to assume responsibilities outside of the classroom as they relate to school.
- 22.) The teacher is to demonstrate a sense of professional responsibility.
- 23.) The teacher is to create an effective environment for learning through functional and attractive displays, bulletin boards, and interest centers.
- 24.) The teacher is to conduct an annual art show.
