**Job Goal:** To develop students physically by providing a wide variety of instructional activities in the physical education classroom; to instruct students about their physical development; to develop in students an understanding of the

games and activities they participate in; to develop cooperation, sportsmanship, and fair play skills in all students.

**Performance Responsibilities:**

- 1.) The teacher is to demonstrate appropriate preparation for classroom instruction.
- 2.) The teacher is to implement a variety of effective teaching techniques.
- 3.) The teacher is to provide opportunities for individual student differences.
- 4.) The teacher is to implement instructional objectives effectively.
- 5.) The teacher is to demonstrate knowledge of his/her subject matter.
- 6.) The teacher is to use a variety of teaching materials.
- 7.) The teacher is to use instructional time effectively.
- 8.) The teacher is to motivate the students in the classroom.
- 9.) The teacher is to demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively with students.
- 10.) The teacher is to provide students with specific evaluative feedback.
- 11.) The teacher is to demonstrate a positive interpersonal relationships with students.
- 12.) The teacher is to demonstrate positive interpersonal relationships with parents and patrons of the community.
- 13.) The teacher is to participate in professional growth activities.
- 14.) The teacher is to follow the policies and procedures of the district as set forth in the staff handbook and board policies of the district.
- 15.) The teacher is to assume responsibilities outside of the classroom as they relate to school.
- 16.) The teacher is to demonstrate a sense of professional responsibility.
- 17.) Beginning in the 1998-99 school year the teacher is to possess the ability to use his/her assigned computer and the following software programs:
  - a.) District selected gradebook
  - b.) District selected e-mail

- c.) District selected word processing
  - d.) District selected operating system
  - e.) District selected on-line reference
- 18.) The teacher is to participate in the development of and utilize the curriculum adopted by the Board of Education.
  - 19.) The teacher is to instruct pupils in citizenship and basic subject matter specified in state law and administrative regulations and procedures.
  - 20.) The teacher is to work cooperatively with classroom teachers to coordinate physical education and classroom curricula when teachers request it.
  - 21.) The teacher is to organize storage areas and control use of materials and equipment to prevent loss or abuse and to minimize time required for distribution and collection.
