- 4.) Write a note about the work completed, the student behavior, and the progress made during the day. This note is to be left for the teacher.
- 5.) Fill out substitute form each day.
- 6.) Report to the principal at the conclusion of the teaching day and verifies whether or not his/her services will be required the next teaching day.
- 7.) Performs such other duties and assumes such other responsibilities as the principal may assign.
